ABOUT THE DIVISION

The Energy, Maritime & Security (EMS) Division of Good Worths Partners Limited (GWPL) is a specialist division established to deliver high-value solutions across three of Nigeria's most strategically critical sectors. Headquartered in Abuja, Federal Capital Territory, the EMS Division operates under the leadership of a Managing Director.



As an emerging but actively growing division of an established Nigerian professional services firm, EMS brings together competencies in renewable energy engineering, oil and gas services, maritime operations, infrastructure security, and defence sector consulting. The Division is structured across two operational clusters: Oil, Gas & Marine and Security & Defence. This enables focused client service delivery while maintaining shared institutional infrastructure and GWPL Group support.



The Division operates within the broader GWPL Group ecosystem, which includes a Professional Services & Technology Division (PST). This institutional architecture gives the EMS Division access to multi-disciplinary support, financial structuring capability, and an established network of senior relationships across Nigeria's energy, finance, and government sectors.

OPERATIONAL CLUSTERS

OIL, GAS & MARINE CLUSTER

The Oil, Gas & Marine Cluster positions GWPL as a credible service partner to International Oil Companies (IOCs), National Oil Companies (NOCs), Engineering, Procurement & Construction (EPC) firms, and maritime operators across Nigeria and the broader Gulf of Guinea. The Cluster delivers services across upstream and downstream energy, renewable energy engineering, vessel operations, and marine logistics.



Energy Services

GWPL's Energy arm is structured around three core business pillars: Engineering, Procurement & Construction (EPC) for solar installations; Power Purchase Agreement / Energy-as-a-Service (PPA/EaaS) models for long-term power supply; and Operations & Maintenance (O&M) for deployed energy assets. GWPL targets C&I (Commercial & Industrial) clients, telecom operators, government facilities, hospitals, and rural communities.



- Solar EPC project delivery for commercial, industrial, and institutional clients.
- Power Purchase Agreements (PPA) and Energy-as-a-Service (EaaS) financing structures.
- Mini-grid development for rural and underserved communities.
- Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) integration and hybrid power solutions.
- Operations, Maintenance & Monitoring (O&M) of deployed solar and energy assets.
- Regulatory engagement with NERC, REA, and state energy agencies.



Oil & Gas Services



GWPL provides project support, vendor services, and consulting across the oil and gas value chain. The Division engages with regulators including the Nigerian Upstream Petroleum Regulatory Commission (NUPRC) and the Nigerian Midstream and Downstream Petroleum Regulatory Authority (NMDPRA), and is positioned to serve both indigenous and international operators.

Maritime Services

Through GWPL Marine, the Cluster delivers a full suite of marine services to vessel operators, offshore asset owners, and port-based clients across Nigeria. GWPL holds NIMASA licensing credentials and OGSIP permit documentation, and operates in full compliance with Nigerian Content regulations.



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- Vessel hire and charter management: offshore support vessels, crew boats, barges, tugboats, patrol vessels, and diving support vessels.
- Marine procurement and logistics coordination.
- NIMASA licensing compliance and OGSIP permit management.
- Maritime contract administration: MOUs, charter agreements, and service contracts.
- AIS-based vessel tracking and maritime intelligence monitoring.
- Gulf of Guinea maritime security advisory and coordination.



SECURITY & DEFENCE CLUSTER

The Security & Defence Cluster provides intelligence-led, technology-enabled security solutions to government agencies, critical infrastructure operators, oil and gas companies, and defence sector institutions. GWPL is actively pursuing the operationalisation of a Global Security Operations Centre (GSOC) in Abuja and an Oil & Gas Security Monitoring Centre (OGSMC) in Lagos, which will give the Division both a national monitoring capability and the physical infrastructure to support strategic clients across Nigeria.



Security Operations & Monitoring

- 24/7 GSOC operations: threat monitoring, incident management, situational awareness, and client notification.
- Deployment of Personnel to Public and Private Sector owned assets.
- OGSMC Lagos: pipeline integrity monitoring, oil theft detection, and offshore asset security.
- AIS maritime monitoring: vessel tracking, dark vessel detection, port zone security (Apapa, Onne, Warri, Calabar).
- Drone surveillance for oil and gas pipelines, critical infrastructure, and remote facilities.
- SIEM-integrated cybersecurity monitoring and intelligence correlation.
- CCTV and access control integration for high-value sites.

Security Consulting & Advisory

- Risk assessment and threat advisory for government institutions, MDAs, and private sector clients.
- Security audit and gap analysis for corporate and critical infrastructure sites.
- HSE and security compliance documentation for regulated sector operators.
- Intelligence-informed security planning and counter-surveillance advisory.



Defence Sector Engagement

- Defence Sector Consulting to the Nigerian Army, Navy, Air Force, and paramilitary agencies.
- Strategic Equipment Procurement for Military and Para-Military organizations.
- Civilian-Military Coordination (CIMIC) operations support.

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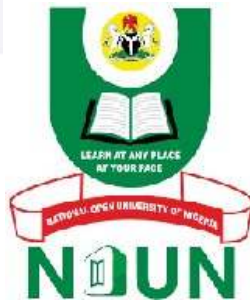
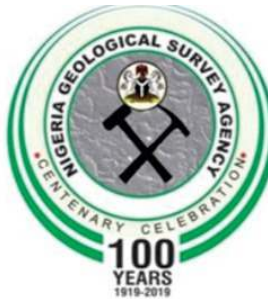
